 - 2026 FCA Health Care Program
 - NRLN Washington Fly-In

2026 Health Care Program

- Pre 65 Retirees/Dependents
 - Annual Enrollment: October 24th November 7th
 - Enroll at Benefit Connect
 - fcabenefits.ehr.com
 - Medical premiums increasing 9.4% on average
 - Dental premium realignment
 - Family tier increase of \$170/yr
 - Child only tier increase of \$72/yr
 - Vision increasing 44% on average

2026 Health Care Program

- Post 65 Retirees/Dependents
 - Annual Enrollment period
 - October 15th December 7th 2025
 - No changes in HRA
 - Retiree receives \$1975 in HRA credits
 - An eligible spouse will receive up to \$1750 in HRA credits
 - HRA Personal report will be available in Benefit Connect
 - fcabenefits.ehr.com
